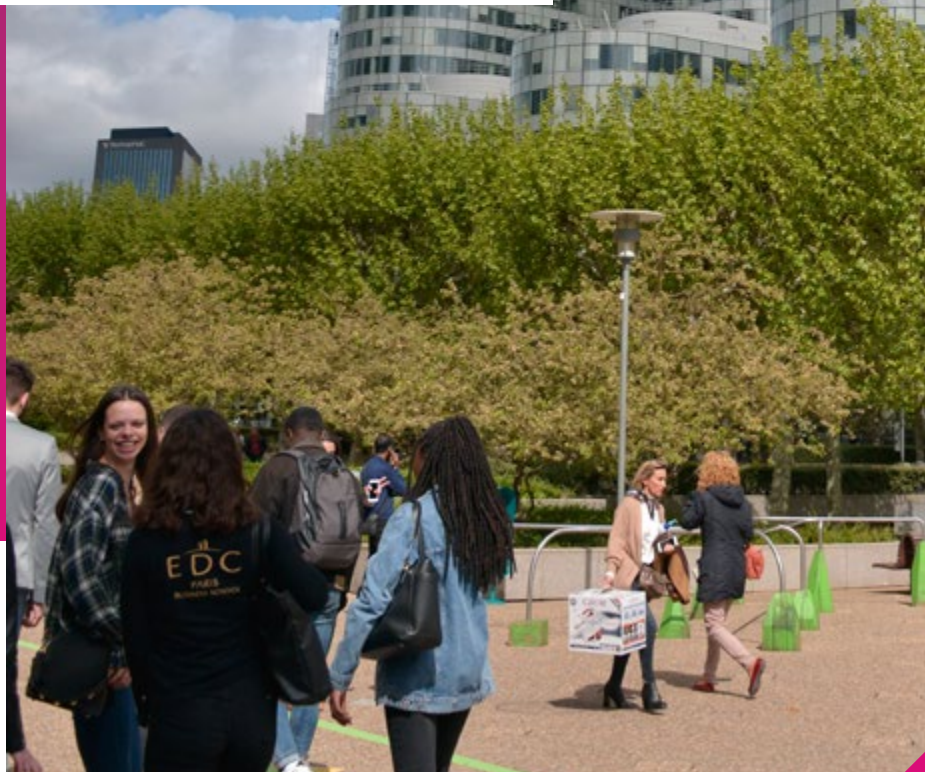

## COURSE SELECTION

- ✓ Provisional course list sent with application documents
- ✓ Confirmation upon arrival during the orientation days. The choice of courses is binding and cannot be modified after the 1st two weeks of the semester.

## COURSE LOAD PER SEMESTER

- ✓ Courses are credited with grades and ECTS credits.
- ✓ Courses generally offer 18 or 36 hours of lecture and require 54 or 108 hours of autonomous course work per semester.
- ✓ On average 7 to 8 courses per week (around 20 hours per week) are necessary to acquire 30 ECTS in one semester.
- ✓ The course selection depends on the requirements of each home institution.
- ✓ Sandwich or study work courses is a possible option for **degree-seeking graduate students ONLY**.
- ✓ It is not possible to choose courses from different programs.

## LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

- ✓ English (some few targeted courses in French)

## LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

- B2 level in English (French for French courses)
- TOEFL IBT: score 80-85; IELTS: 6.5
- DELF: score 50/100 (minimum)

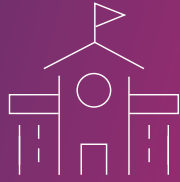
